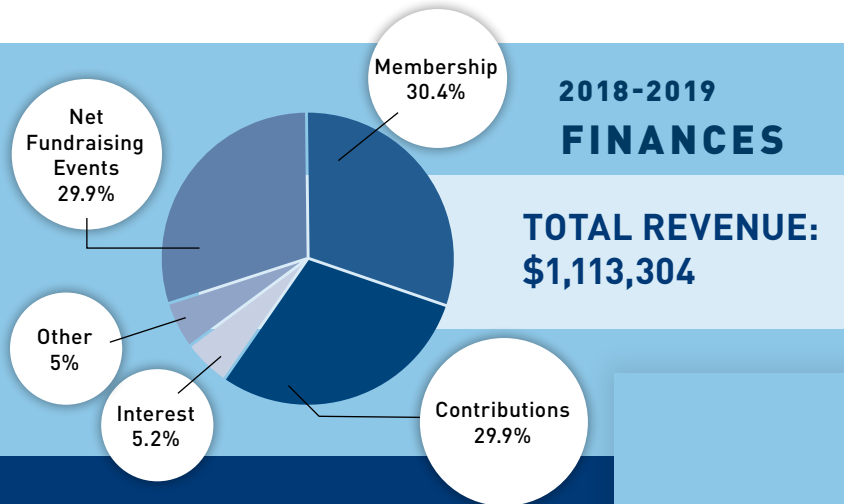


THE JUNIOR LEAGUE OF TAMPA

Developing women leaders. Building a better community.

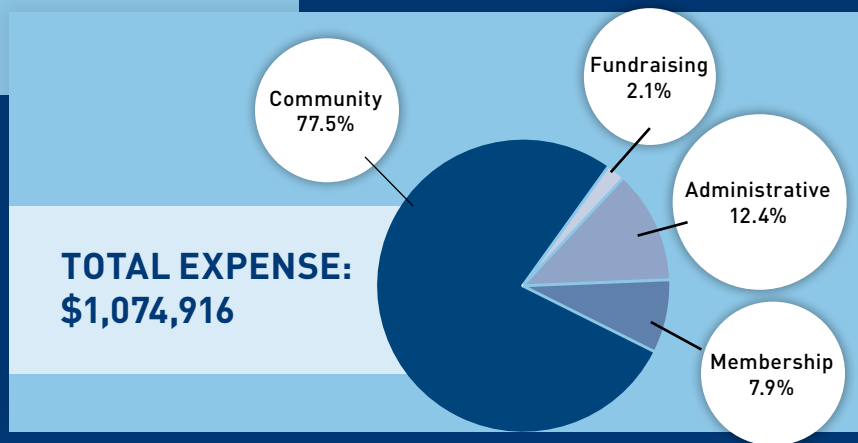
