## **VOLUNTEER INFORMATION**

### **DRESS CODE**

- Dragon Boat volunteer shirt: Pick up from HQ prior to event day, or at the Volunteer Tent at the start of your shift
- Black athletic shorts or leggings
- Athletic shoes: You will be walking around a lot! For those volunteering for the dock marshalling shifts, consider wearing waterproof or water-friendly shoes
- Hat, sunglasses and sunscreen: Strongly recommended

### **CHECKING IN**

- Please check in 15 minutes prior to your shift start so that we may provide brief training and guide you to the correct location
- Check in at the Volunteer Tent between the food trucks and the Athlete Village

### **VOLUNTEER SERVICES**

- A light breakfast will be available to those covering the early morning move-in shifts
- A lunch voucher for food trucks will be given to those whose shifts cover the 11:00 am to 1:00 pm period entirely
- Snacks, water, Gatorade, hand sanitizer and sunscreen will be available to all volunteers throughout the day at the dock, at the Volunteer Tent and at the air-conditioned Volunteer Break Room on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Marriott Waterside Hotel

### **PARKING**

Due to the ongoing Water Street and Convention Center construction, parking and street access may be limited. We are unable to provide parking passes, but we will provide up-to-date parking and alternative transportation information closer to the festival date.

### **IMPORTANT**

- Temperatures are expected to be over 80 degrees the day of the festival
- Volunteers will all be working outside in the Florida heat and many shifts will take place in areas with minimal shade
- It is extremely important that you stay hydrated, wear sunscreen and a hat, and pay very close attention to any signs of **heat exhaustion**
- If you feel yourself getting overheated, please notify the Volunteer Tent and take a break in the air-conditioned Volunteer Break Room on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Marriott Waterside Hotel
- First Aid personnel will be driving around festival grounds in a golf cart
